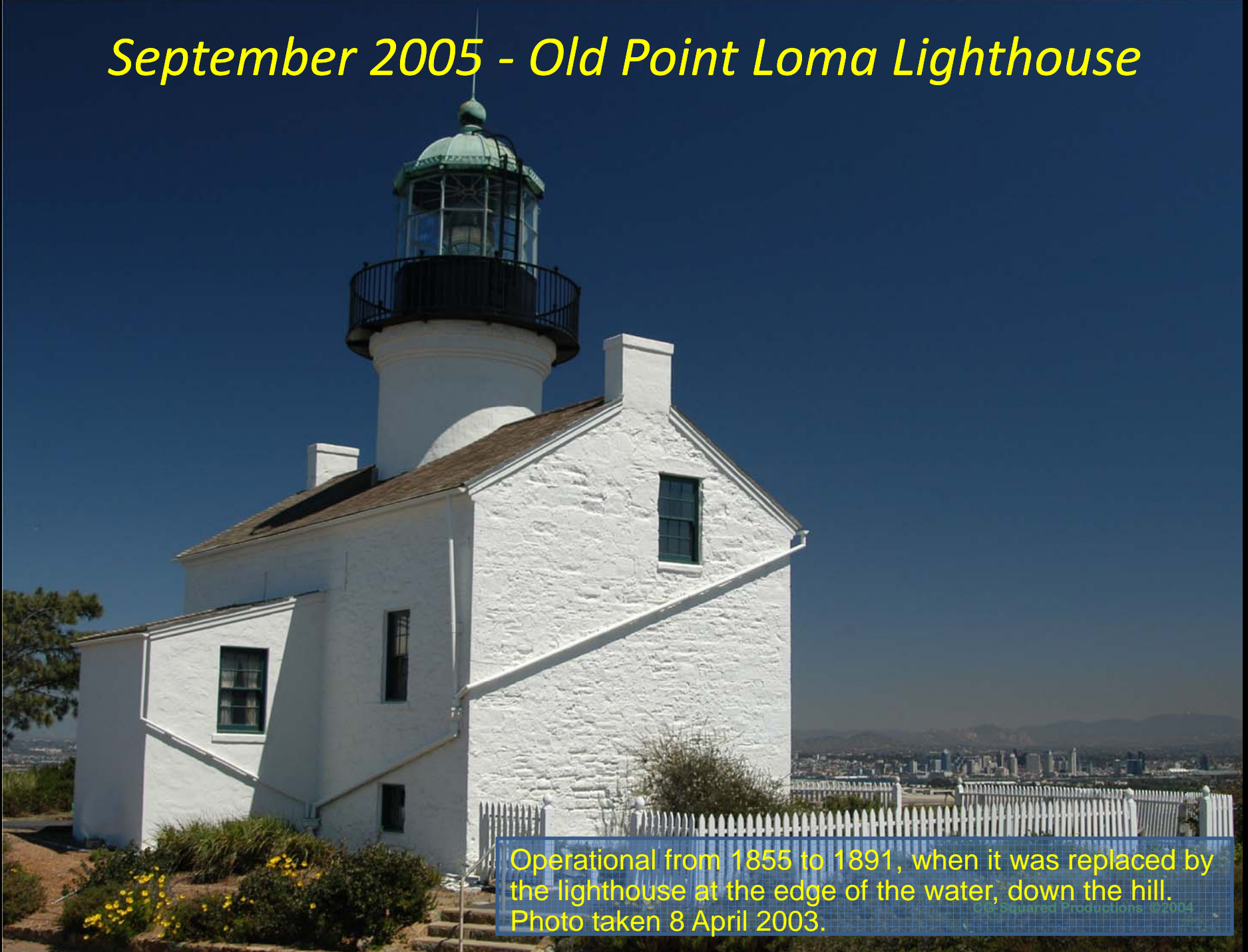


Looking northwest from saddle between Mortero Wash and Goat Canyon, Laguna Mountain on the horizon, 28 April 2003.

looking past Carrizo Gorge, 15 May 2003.

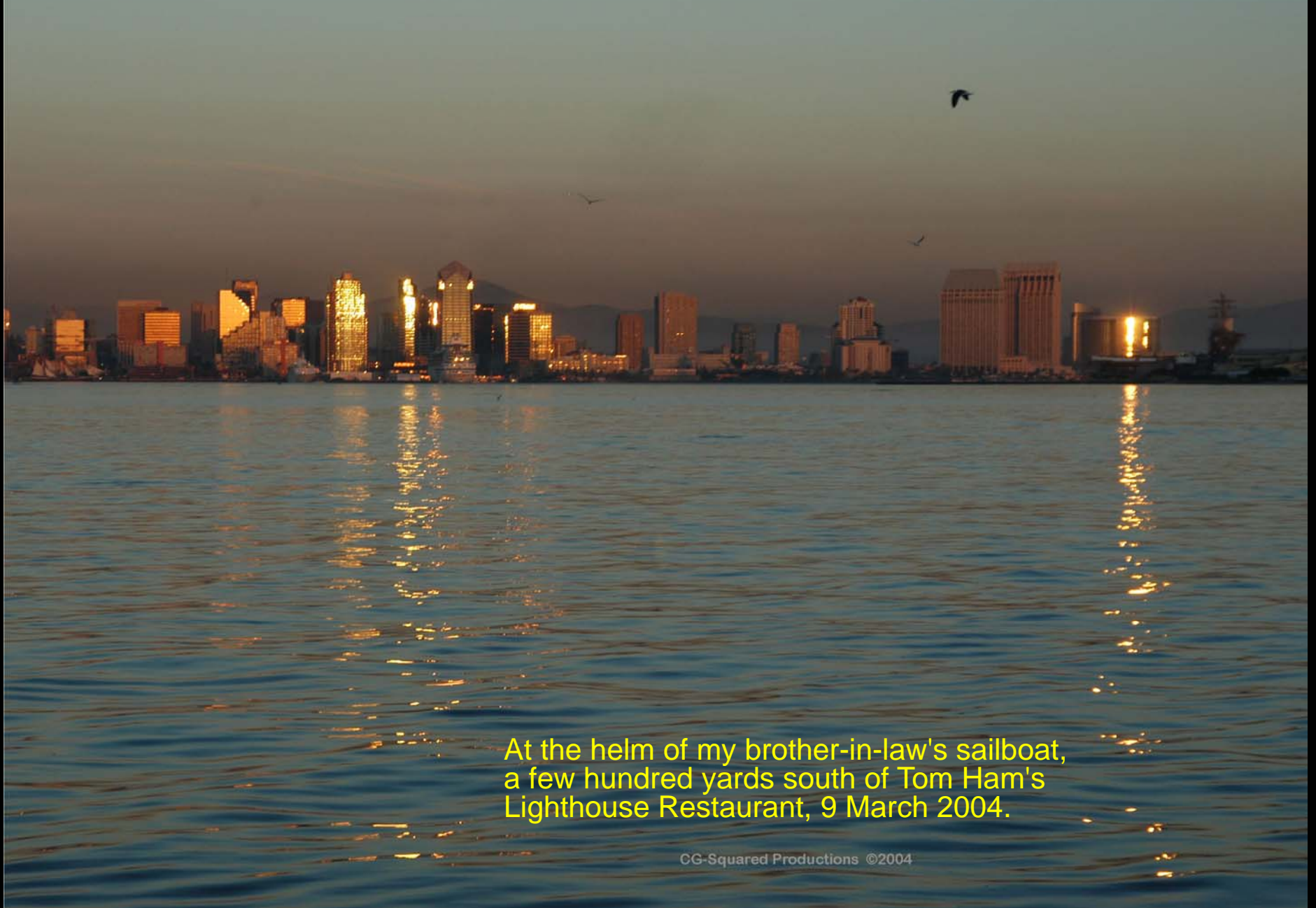
November 2005 - Acorn Woodpecker Holes

October - lunar eclipse of May 2003, from above Sacatone Springs, looking east

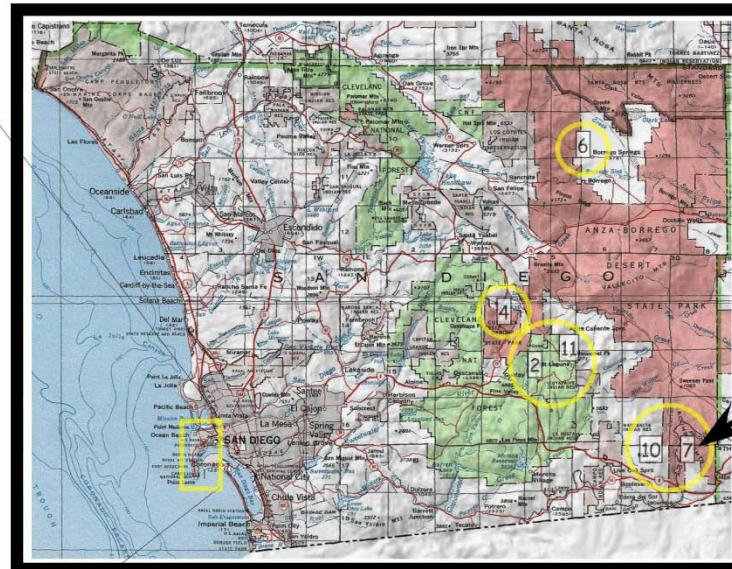


November - acorn woodpecker traces in the Laguna mountains
